FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS | 1Q 2022

- Net operating revenues up 16.2% y-o-y to NOK 1 138 million
 - Partially due to high number of working days and acquisitions
 - Organic growth in net operating revenues was 1.6%
- Strong EBITA* of NOK 169.2 million (98.5), margin of 14.9%
- Reported profit for the period was NOK 121.6 million (66.6)
- Other opex** ratio 15.2% from 14.6% same period last year
- Improved billing ratio 71.4%, up 0.3pp from last year
- Strong order intake of NOK 1 467 million (1 381)






